New Jersey Lottery Submission for World Lottery Association Responsible Gaming Innovation Award

The New Jersey Lottery is proud to have received World Lottery Association Level 3 Responsible Gaming certification. The Lottery is preparing to submit an application for Level 4 certification and appreciates this opportunity to submit the following entry for consideration for a Responsible Gaming INNOVATION Award for one of the initiatives described in the Level 4 application: the New Jersey Lottery's Targeted Responsible Gaming Advertising to At-Risk Groups program.

Organizational Profile

Since the New Jersey Lottery's inception in 1970, it has been dedicated to maximizing revenues in support of education and institutions in a responsible manner. The Lottery has longstanding partnerships with problem gambling prevention and treatment providers that keep it informed with regard to changing behavioral patterns among consumers. The Lottery is a member of the Council on Compulsive Gambling of New Jersey, Inc. (CCGNJ) and has had a seat on CCGNJ's Board of Directors since 1999. These relationships aid the Lottery in serving the people of the State of New Jersey by expanding its customer base while minimizing adverse social consequences.

In March 2015, the Lottery received Level 3 Responsible Gaming Certification from the World Lottery Association, and the Lottery's application for Level 4 certification is being submitted to the WLA in October 2016.

Overview

The New Jersey Lottery is an executive agency of the government of the State of New Jersey, established in 1970 by the State Lottery Law as a separate division of the New Jersey Department of Treasury. The Division of Lottery includes the New Jersey State Lottery Commission, the Executive Director of the Lottery, and various operating units. The Commission is a seven-member oversight board that includes the State Treasurer and six public members appointed by the Governor of the State of New Jersey.

In June 2013, a competitively bid, 15-year (plus a 9-month portion of the State's 2014 fiscal year) Lottery Growth Management Services contract was awarded to Northstar New Jersey Lottery Group, LLC (Northstar New Jersey) for the purpose of increasing Lottery sales and net income. Northstar New Jersey provides the New Jersey Lottery with game design innovation, technology enhancements, sales and marketing management, and other services. These services are provided by Northstar New Jersey staff and Northstar New Jersey's parent companies, International Game Technology (IGT) and Scientific Games International (SGI), the world's leading gaming companies.

The New Jersey Lottery has long been committed to responsible gaming practices. Northstar New Jersey, IGT, SGI, and all the other members of the New Jersey Lottery public/private partnership are dedicated to continuously maintaining and improving the Lottery's responsible gaming program.

Mission and Vision

The mission of the New Jersey State Lottery is to raise revenues for maximum contribution to State education and institutions benefiting the citizens of New Jersey through the responsible sale of lottery products. This is accomplished by providing entertaining products through a dynamic public business

enterprise built upon honesty, integrity, customer satisfaction, teamwork and public/private partnerships.

Product Portfolio

The New Jersey Lottery's product portfolio consists of Draw Based Games, Fast Play Games and Instant Games.

Pick 4	Draw Based Game, \$0.50 per play, daily midday and evening drawings. Daily Lottery game in which the player picks any 4-digit number from 0000 to 9999. No minimum jackpot.
Pick 3	Draw Based Game, \$0.50 per play, daily midday and evening drawings. Daily Lottery game in which the player picks any 3-digit number from 000 to 999. No minimum jackpot.
Fast Play	A series of games launched in 2015 offering quick play styles, similar to Instant Games. Tickets are printed on demand from Lottery terminals. Players do not need to select numbers or wait for a drawing to determine if they have a winning ticket. Fast Play games are offered at various prices and play styles with new games added frequently.
Instant Games	\$1-\$30 per ticket. About 45 new instant games are introduced each year.

Economic Impact

The New Jersey Lottery is the State of New Jersey's fourth-largest revenue producer, contributing a total of more than \$24 billion since its inception, and close to a billion dollars in each of the last five fiscal years (FY12-FY16), to State education and institutions. Beneficiaries of the Lottery's contributions include the New Jersey Department of Education, New Jersey Higher Educational Services, the New Jersey Department of Human Services, the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, and the New Jersey School Nutrition Program. The Lottery contributes to local businesses by issuing licenses to more than 7,200 retailers statewide for the sale of Lottery tickets, for which retailers earn sales and prize payment commissions. For FY16, ending June 30, 2016, the Lottery generated operating revenues of more than \$3 billion and contributed over \$980 million to the New Jersey Treasury for distribution to beneficiaries.

New Jersey Lottery Innovation: Targeted Responsible Gaming Advertising to At-risk Groups

In 2016, the New Jersey Lottery decided to improve the effectiveness of its responsible gaming program by identifying locations where the need for problem gambling prevention and treatment information is greatest and concentrating on delivering newly created responsible gaming messages to those locations.

The new program is based on enhanced reporting the Lottery requested from the Council on Compulsive Gambling of New Jersey (CCGNJ) to show not only the number, but also the county of origin, for calls to CCGNJ's 1-800-GAMBLER® problem gambling Helpline. CCGNJ also began reporting the localities from which the 800gambler.org website received the most visits. The additional data allowed the Lottery to compile a list that ranked all twenty-one counties in the State of New Jersey from the highest to the lowest demand for problem gambling prevention and treatment information. (See attached reports and analysis). The Lottery then created a new series of responsible gaming advertisements (See four attached advertisements) and launched a newspaper and digital advertising campaign to concentrate delivery of the new messages in the five counties where the need was greatest.

Each of the new advertisements features the message "If you or someone you know has a gambling problem, call 1-800-GAMBLER®," together with the "Not 18 Yet? No Bet™ logo of the Lottery's underage gambling prevention program and the Lottery's standard responsible gaming messages, "Must be 18 or older to buy a lottery ticket" and "Please play responsibly."

The new advertisements include four themes, to be published quarterly in the targeted counties:

"Dream Big. Play Responsibly. Know your limits" (Summer 2016)

"Some things just aren't a good fit. Lottery tickets aren't child's play" (Autumn 2016)

"'Tis the season to gift responsibly. Lottery tickets aren't child's play" (Winter 2016-17)

Lottery "Pool Rules. Tips and tricks to keep your pool cool" (Spring 2017)

The first targeted responsible gaming advertisement - "Dream Big. Play Responsibly. Know your limits" - was published in newspapers covering five critical counties: Atlantic, Essex, Middlesex, Passaic and Ocean. That advertisement was featured in 34 different newspapers reaching 440,347 subscribers.

Effectiveness of the new advertisements can be monitored by surveying selected members of the Lottery's Game Changers online research panel to measure increased awareness of responsible gaming information. In addition, the origins of calls to the 1-800-GAMBLER Helpline and visits to the 800gambler.org website can be correlated with the locations where New Jersey Lottery retailers most frequently use the Problem Gambling Helpline button on their lottery terminals to print referral messages for their customers, with that additional information being used to further refine the identification of critical areas for targeted delivery of responsible gaming messages.
